Information about ZAPP

During our January meeting, members brought up their concern and raised questions about building an online portfolio and entering their work into art festivals. Zapplication came up in the conversation and a few members testified to their satisfaction with the website www.zapplication.org.

It is free and while it may appear confusing to those unfamiliar with online entry and portfolio building, it has very comprehensible step-by-step instructions. It enables individual artists to apply online for multiple art shows. The online application process also allows artists to directly upload digital images of their artwork for jury review. The result is that all artwork in the system is in a consistent, high quality, digital format. The digital images are presented to the jurors of each show, and the system allows them to score online. I encourage those of you who art interested in exploring this option to look into it. Again, the website is www.zapplication.org.


